Community Health Services

This clinical practice component is crucial for I-Systems College nursing students to build and strengthen their professional competencies. During their training, students are assigned to community placements where they conduct home visits. These visits follow established standard operating procedures to assess the health of both the mother and baby, identifying any signs of abnormal conditions. When necessary, students refer the cases to appropriate healthcare providers and continue monitoring through scheduled follow-up visits.
